

Director Playing With Walk-Ins at Tuesday Games

It is Club policy that the Game Director for Tuesday games does not play. However, he/she is encouraged to play with any walk-in bridge player, and try to make arrangements to fill in the movement to avoid half tables. Walk-ins are people who have come from other clubs and do not regularly play at the Club.

If a member arrives to play on a Tuesday and their prearranged partner does not show up, the Game Director will try to rearrange tables to accommodate the situation, but cannot guarantee that the member gets to play that day.

Potential Solutions to Avoid Arriving and Partner Not Showing:

--Contact partner the day before or the day of to confirm that partner will be at the game.

--Contact the Partnership Committee Member at least 24 hours before the game to find an alternate partner.

--Have an alternate lined up in case your partner does not show.

Team Games: (Tuesday and Thursday Sessions)

The Game Director does Not play in team games (i.e. Swiss Teams) so players must ensure that they arrive with four (4) people per team. If they do not have four players, they will not be able to play in the game unless an extra person or pair can be found other than the Game Director.
